

# Library Books for Your Nook



Checkout and download free Adobe e-books from the Library's North Suburban Digital Consortium and transfer them to your Nook device using Adobe Digital Editions.

## Here's what you'll need:

- Home computer with Internet connection. (PC or Mac)
- E-mail address.
- Nook device such as Simple Touch, Nook Color or Nook Tablet.
- Valid Algonquin Area Public Library Card.
- USB Cord for your Nook.

## Step 1: Install and Activate Adobe Digital Editions

In order to read an Adobe e-book on your computer or transfer it to a Nook, you will first need to install Adobe Digital Editions on your PC or Mac. ADE is free software that manages your library e-book downloads and protects the copyrights of the authors and publishers.

- If you don't already have one, create an Adobe ID and password at [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com).
  - Click on Sign In.
  - Click Create an Adobe Account.
  - Register your Name, E-mail address, Country, City and Zip Code.
  - Click Continue.
- Download and install the free Adobe Digital Editions software at <http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions>
- Authorize your computer with your Adobe ID and password when prompted by the Setup Assistant. Once authorized, close Adobe Digital Editions.


- Next, connect your Nook to your computer and wait a few moments for the device to be recognized.
- Open Adobe Digital Editions again and follow the prompt to authorize your Nook device with your Adobe ID and password.

*(Note: Should you ever need to deactivate a computer, you can do so by holding down Control, Shift and D)*

## Step 2: Checkout and Download an Adobe E-book from Overdrive

- Visit <http://nsdc.lib.overdrive.com>
- Sign in with your Algonquin Library Card Number.
- Add an available Adobe e-book to your BookBag.
- Click Proceed to Checkout.
- Confirm your Checkout.
- Download the file.

## Step 3: Transfer the Adobe E-book to Your Nook

- Open the ebook file (.ascm) in Adobe Digital Editions.
- Go to **Library View** by clicking on . Your Nook should appear as a bookshelf.
- Click on the e-book title and drag it to the Nook bookshelf with your mouse.
- After copying your e-book to your Nook, remember to safely eject your device from the computer and unplug.
- The e-book will appear in the My Documents or My Files folder on your Nook.

ENJOY YOUR FREE E-BOOK!

If the title you want is checked out, you can place a hold. You will be notified via email when the title is available for you to checkout. The e-book will be reserved for you for 3 days. You can hold up to 15 e-books at one time.

*Note: Library e-books are not compatible with the Nook app. Use the free Overdrive App for your mobile device instead.*
