

- Log in to your Amazon Account
- Select your Kindle device
- The book will be delivered wirelessly to your Kindle.*

* Wireless delivery requires WiFi - your Kindle's 3G connection is not sufficient. Also, some publishers may require you to transfer library books via USB. See instructions below.

How do I transfer an e-book to my Kindle via USB?

- Download and save the Kindle book to your computer's desktop.
- Connect the USB Cord between Your Computer and Kindle.
- Your Kindle will appear as an External Hard Drive
- Move the Kindle book to the "documents" folder on your Kindle.
- Eject the Kindle and disconnect from the Computer.

How Do I Return an E-book?

All e-books automatically expire after 14 days, so you don't need to return the e-book. However, you do have the option of returning an e-book early. This makes the e-book available for other patrons and frees up your account to check out more e-books. You may have 15 e-books checked out to your card at a time.

Kindle Users:

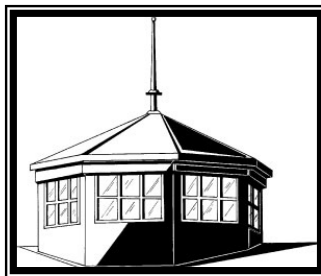
- Log in to your Amazon account
- Click Manage My Kindle
- Select Action > Return

Adobe Digital Editions:

- Go to Library View
- Click the Item Options Arrow next to the e-book
- Select Return Borrowed Item

App Users:

- Go to Bookshelf
- Tap Edit > Red Dot > Delete >
- Return then Delete

The Algonquin Area Public Library District offers free e-book downloads to AAPLD card holders at www.aapld.org/online/ebooks.asp.

What are e-books?

An e-book is a digital version of a print book that can be read on computers, mobile devices, or eReaders such as Kindles and Nooks. The Library has e-books available in the following formats:

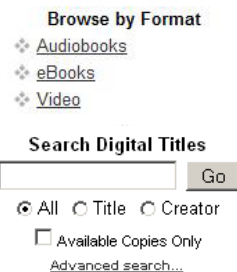
- DRM Protected Adobe® EPUB e-books
- DRM Protected Adobe® PDF e-books
- DRM Protected Amazon Kindle e-books

Which eReaders are compatible with Library e-books from Overdrive?

Most eReaders are now compatible with Library e-books from Overdrive, including Nooks, Kindles, Sony Readers, Kobos, iPads, and Android devices. For a more complete list of compatible devices and formats visit <http://overdrive.com/resources/drc/>.

How do I access the Library's collection of e-books?

Go to www.aapld.org/online/ebooks.asp and click on the link to the North Suburban Digital Consortium (Overdrive).



- Browse e-books by clicking on the link under Browse by format.

- Search for e-books by title, author, genre, or format using Advanced Search.

How do I check out an e-book from Overdrive?

- Add an available title to your Bookbag.
- Click Proceed to Checkout.
- Sign in with your Library Card number.
- Confirm Checkout.
- Download file.

How do I place a hold on an e-book?

- From within the North Suburban Digital Consortium web site, click on the link 'Currently Checked Out - Place a Hold.'
- Enter and confirm your e-mail address.
- Click on the button 'Currently Checked Out—Place a Hold.'
- You will be notified via email when the title is available for you to checkout. The e-book will be reserved for you for 3 days.
- You can hold up to 10 e-books at one time.

What is a Wish List?

Wish Lists are a way of keeping track of e-books you might want to check out or place on hold in the future.

Is There an App for That?

Of course! Free apps are available from Overdrive enabling you select, download and read Adobe EPUB e-books and MP3 audiobooks on your mobile device or tablet. The following platforms are currently supported: *Android, Blackberry phones, iOs (Apple), and Windows Phone.*

Do I Need to Install Adobe Digital Editions?

The answer varies by device. Adobe Digital Editions is free software that is used to read and transfer Adobe EPUB and PDF Library e-books from your PC or Mac to certain eReader devices. If you're using one of the following eReaders, you will need to install Adobe Digital Editions to transfer e-books to your device:

- Nook (E-ink)
- Nook (Color)
- Kobo Touch
- Kobo WiFi
- Pandigital Novel
- Literati

- You can download and install this free software for your PC or Mac at www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/.

Note: Kindles, iPads, Sony Readers, and Tablets running standard Android operating systems do not need to install Adobe Digital Editions.

Do I need an Adobe ID to read Adobe PDF and Adobe EPUB e-books from Overdrive?

- If you want to access your e-book on more than one computer, or read it on a mobile device or compatible eReader, you will need to create an Adobe ID and password.
- If you do not already have an Adobe ID, click 'get an Adobe ID online' when prompted by Adobe Digital Editions or your mobile app and follow the instructions.
- You can also create an Adobe account at www.adobe.com.

How do I authorize my eReader for use with Adobe Digital Editions Software?

- Once your computer is authorized by the Setup Assistant, *close* Adobe Digital Editions.
- Connect the e-book device to your computer and *then open* Adobe Digital Editions again.
- Adobe Digital Editions launches and detects the e-book device. The 'Device Setup Assistant' dialog box is displayed.
- Click 'Authorize Device'. Adobe Digital Editions activates the e-book device.
- You can now transfer DRM-protected Adobe e-books to the device.

How do I transfer Adobe PDF and Adobe EPUB e-books using Adobe Digital Editions?

- After authorizing your device with the same Adobe ID as your PC or Mac, your e-book device will appear as a bookshelf within Digital Editions' Library whenever connected to the computer.
- You can transfer downloaded e-books to and from your device by simply dragging and dropping files to and from the bookshelf.

How do I check out an e-book for my Kindle?

- Go to <http://nsdc.lib.overdrive.com>.
- Check out a Kindle book (library card required).
- Click on "Get for Kindle."
- Click Get Library Book
